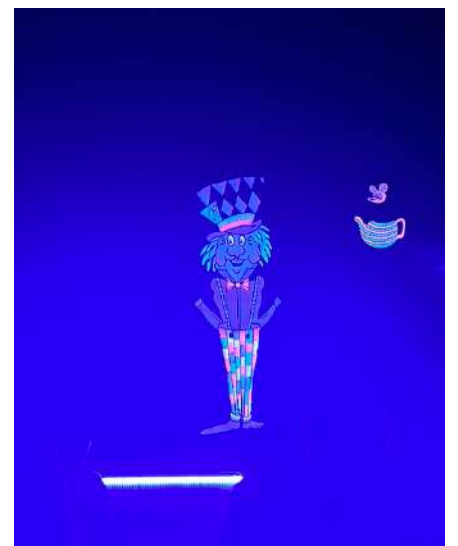

Our tamariki had an amazing time at Pomaria last week watching the amazing Glow Show.



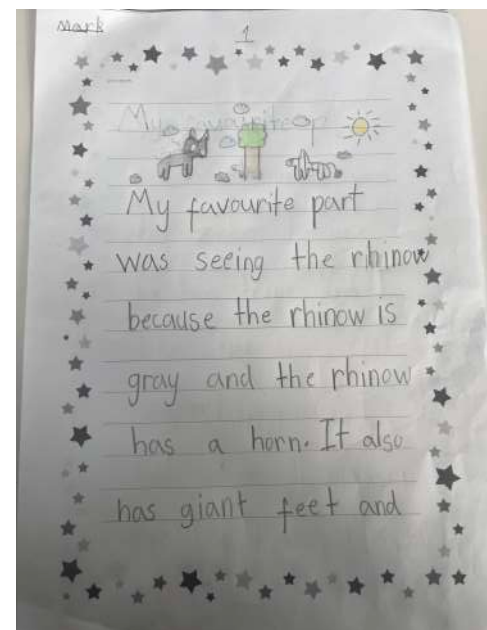
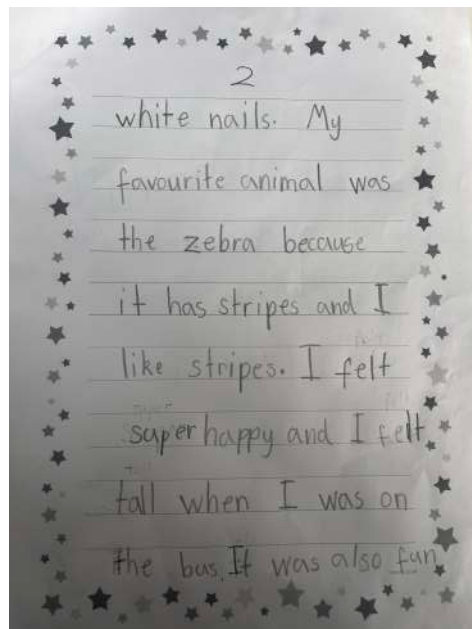
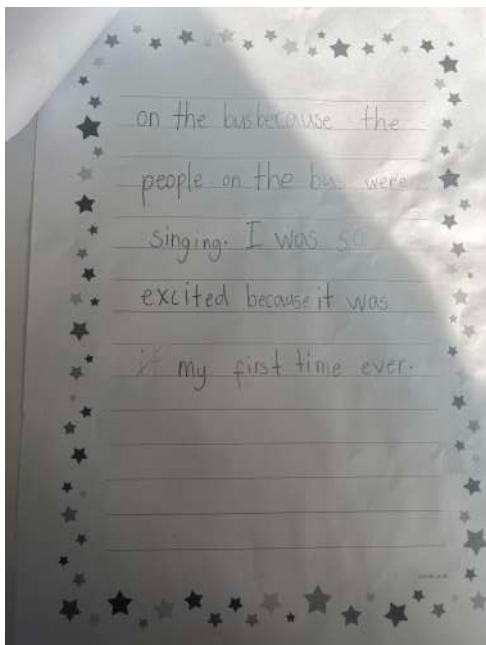
Zoo Trip

Te Uru Art Gallery Trip

All the year 4's were very excited about their visit to Te Uru Gallery in Titirangi. Some students had never been to an Art Gallery before. They had a fabulous time learning about how to create their own mini piece of artwork, creating a unique series of stylised symbols focusing on identity using batik (cold wax and dye) methods onto fabric. We even got to see the exhibition by Rozana Lee who we based our art work on. She is of Indonesian and Chinese heritage, and her work reflects experiences of migration, identity, and belonging. Rozana Lee creates intricately patterned fabrics mostly using silk fabric, wax and dye. Lee's exhibition connects different cultures through common symbols and motifs relating to their traditions, mythologies and beliefs.
